Creative Crafts is a year-long course (1.0) that focuses on the Creative Arts. The Elements and Principles of Art and Design will guide students as they create a variety of functional and decorative projects. Basic concepts in drawing, painting, sculpture and collage will begin the school year. Students will build upon their knowledge of drawing and apply artistic skills to a variety of crafts, including paper arts, fiber arts and sculpture. Throughout the course, students will work through color theory, perspective and learn about a variety of artists and cultural influences.

Class Expectations:

- Students are expected to be on time, in regular attendance and prepared for class.
 - Entering the studio late 3 times will warrant a call home and detention.
- No Food or Drink is allowed in the art studio without permission.
- Cell Phones are to be stored in the student locker as per the CCSD's Code of Conduct.
 - Having a phone in class will warrant subsequent behavioral action.
- Students are to complete each art project on time and in accordance with the project guidelines and rubrics. (see Google Classroom).
- All projects must be completed by the end of the marking period.
 - For every day absent, students will receive that many days as an extension to complete the work.
- All students are required to be part of the Google Classroom and to know how to upload images and information to assignments posted.
- All students are expected to follow the Rules of the Studio.
- The art studio is a community. Being respectful to ourselves, each other and the art work created is an important piece of the collective artistic process.

To foster independence and encourage student ownership, the procedure for a student who is unsure about a grade is as follows: 1. Schedule a student meeting with me (most grade questions can be resolved at this step) 2. If the grade in question is unresolved after the student-teacher meeting, please feel free to email me or schedule a parent teacher meeting.
