## **Student Expectations**

## In Class

- LATENESS TO CLASS IS UNACCEPTABLE WITHOUT A VALID REASON. Students who are continually late will receive a contact to their parents and possible administrative referral.
- ALL CELLPHONE will be quieted and put away, a wall pouch is provided for those who feel they can not successfully keep their phone away.

- All students are expected to come to class on time with their guided notes and HW packets ready to learn
- Students will be expected to follow all safety and social distancing protocols
  - Still recommended to use of hand sanitizer upon entering/leaving the classroom
- Students are expected to participate in a positive and constructive manner
- Participation will consist of answering questions asked of any individual; reading out loud and or contributing to the subject being studied
- Late assignments will be accepted for a reduced grade.

### At Home

- Paper assignments will be started in class then taken home to complete.
- Note can be filled out in digital format or in hard copy if requested.
- All students must log in to google classroom to complete classwork, homework and assignments.
- Students should complete video lessons and assignments by the due date and time
- Late assignments will be accepted for a reduced grade.

#### Labs:

- <u>Conduct</u>: The purpose of the lab is to give you some experience in "being a scientist".
   These experiences will include safely following prescribed lab procedures and handling delicate and costly equipment. Students who fail to conduct themselves appropriately will be removed from the lab. Furthermore, a student may be held financially responsible for damage of the equipment through carelessness or misuse.
- <u>Preparation</u>: Since all labs have a limited amount of working time, it is essential that the student comes to the lab prepared to work. <u>Absences from lab days are</u> <u>discouraged</u>.

### Lab section continued

- <u>Laboratory Requirements:</u> The successful completion of the laboratory program is a prerequisite for the admission to the Regents exam in June. This includes the complete and satisfactorily written lab reports collected and kept in the lab folder.
- <u>Make-up Labs</u>: Absences on lab days should be avoided whenever possible. If you miss a lab period, plan on making up the missed lab work as soon as you return to school. Missed labs **MUST** be made up.

# Quarter/Midterm/ Regents Exam description and grade weight

\*These will be subject to change based on the state and district decisions

- Quarters: Each of the four quarters is worth 21% of your total grade.
- <u>Midterms:</u> There will be a cumulative midterm exam given at the midpoint of the year. Dates of these exams will be announced to students with sufficient time to prepare. The Midterm exam counts as 6% of your total grade
- Regents Exam: Students will take the Living Environment Regents exam in June. This will count towards 10% of your final grade.
