


ELA Regents District to State Proficiency Comparison

Percent Scoring at Levels for All Students








Geometry Regents (New Exam - June 2025) District to State Proficiency Comparison

Percent Scoring at Levels for All Students








Algebra II District to State Proficiency Comparison




Living Environment (Last Administration of Old Exam - 32 students) District to State Proficiency Comparison




Life Science: Biology (New Exam - 280 students) District to State Proficiency Comparison

Percent Scoring at Levels for All Students








Physical Setting/Earth Science (Last Administration of Old Exam)

Percent Scoring at Levels for All Students








Chemistry District to State Proficiency Comparison




Physical Setting/Physics District to State Proficiency Comparison




Global History & Geography II District to State Proficiency Comparison




Exam Requirements

In addition to the 22 units of credit, students must also meet the NYS exam requirements to earn a diploma.

To meet the exam requirements, students must pass 4 exams + 1 pathway. All students must pass one exam (Regents exam or Department-approved alternative) in each of the four subject areas (English, mathematics, science, social studies) plus one pathway.

Current NYS Diploma Requirements & Regents Exam requirements:

To graduate from a New York State high school, students **must pass five Regents exams** with a score of at least 65%. **The exams must include one each** of English Language Arts (ELA), math, science, and social studies. Students can choose from a variety of exams in each subject category.

Regents Exams Offered Based on the Above Criteria:

- English Language Arts (ELA): Required for all students (taken in 11th grade)
- Math: Students can choose from Algebra I, Geometry, or Algebra II/Trigonometry
- **Science**: Students can choose from Living Environment, Chemistry, Earth Science, or Physics
- **Social Studies**: Students can choose from Global History and Geography or U.S. History and Government






Advanced Placement Exam Stats Total Number of Students Sitting for Each Exam 2023 - 2025

484 AP (College Board Advanced Placement) exams

47 of our AP students in 2025 were considered **AP Scholars** (received a 3 or higher on 5 or more exams)

17 of our AP students in 2025 were considered **AP Honors** (received a 3 or higher on 4 or more exams)

21 of our AP students in 2025 were considered AP with Distinction

CCHS has a 83% rate overall of obtaining a 3 or higher on AP exams over the last 6 years
