Dear Cornwall Central School District Families,

Students' weight and height are measured as part of the required school health examination. These numbers are used to figure out the student's body mass index or 'BMI'. The BMI helps the doctor or nurse know if the student's weight is in a healthy range or is too high/low. NYS Education Law requires BMI and weight status group to be included as part of the student's school health examination and a sample of school districts are selected to take part in a survey by the NYS Department of Health. Schools only report **summary information** about students' weight status groups; individual student names are NOT sent. However, you may choose to have your child's information excluded from this survey report.

The information sent to the NYS Department of Health will help health officials develop programs that make it easier for children to be healthier. If you do not wish to have your child's weight status group information included as part of the Health Department's survey this year please contact your child's school nurse by November 30, 2022 using the contact information below:
