Course Description:

Seventh grade English Language Arts is a combination of lesson plans and activities in reading, writing, listening, speaking, and viewing. This course is divided into four Thematic Units. The Workshop Model of Instruction will be utilized to deliver engaging, student centered lessons and tasks. English Lessons are standards based, using the Next Generation Learning Standards for English Language Arts. Reading Workshop includes reading short stories, poetry, nonfiction texts, and class novels. Writing Workshop incorporates prompt writing, the writing process, and mini lessons that focus on voice, style, adding details, grammar skills, and revision skills. Students will create a writing portfolio that contains the following types of writing: literary responses, research report, argumentative essays, informational writing, poetry, narrative writing, and others.

Thematic Units and Central Texts Grade 7 English

- ★ Unit 1 Facing Adversity- *Elements of Plot*-a variety of short stories, non-fiction texts, and poetry.
- ★ Unit 2 Turning Points and Transformations-A Christmas Carol: Scrooge and Marley (play)-Charles Dickens, Gift of the Magi- O. Henry, The Treasure of Lemon Brown- Walter Dean Myers, other excerpts/selections.
- ★ Unit 3 Taking a Stand/ Argumentative Writing- Novel Study: Freak the Mighty-Rodman Philbrick (General), Gathering Blue-Lois Lowry (Accelerated) and nonfiction articles with argumentative topics.
- ★ Unit 4 Folktales and Fairytales: A Cinderella Story, Multicultural Unit- Cinderella (The Little Glass Slipper)-Charles Perault, a variety of multicultural Cinderella Stories, and a variety of short stories, non-fiction, poetry.

Academic Expectations:

Students are expected to come to class prepared with all required daily materials. In the event of a brief absence, students are to contact me as soon as possible and check the absent work folder located in the front of the classroom upon their return. Important to note, students are expected to maintain academic integrity at all times. Work that is copied or plagiarized is not permitted and will not be accepted.

Grading Scale:

- → Writing Assignments and Projects*- 40%
- → Quizzes and Tests*- 40%
 - *Students may choose to make corrections/revisions to improve their grade after teacher conference
- → Classwork and Homework**-20%
 - **Homework will be assigned when there is a need to complete classwork activities and/or readings or if there is a particular skill or concept that needs reinforcement. Homework assignments will be posted in our Google Classroom Stream as a reminder.

Independent Reading-Twenty Five Books Campaign:

Students are encouraged to:

- Self select independent reading books
- Read an independent reading book for a minimum 20 minutes each day. This is your daily homework assignment.
- Conference with the teacher to check for appropriate reading level and comprehension.
- Maintain an updated Annotated Bibliography of their finished texts.

The Young Novelist Project:

The Young Novelist Project is a year-long writing project modeled after the NANOWRIMO writing project. This project is a fun and empowering approach to creative writing that challenges students to write a 10,000 word novel over the course of the school year. Each month, students will be guided through the process of narrative writing. Students will brainstorm, draft, revise, edit, and publish their novels. The end of the school year will include a YNP celebration in which students will receive a bound copy of their novel.
