

# *Class Expectations*

## *Library Program – CCMS*

-The library has an interactive program. Students often work on literary based activities and projects. All students are expected to participate.

-A student can be moved from their desk to a back table for disruptive behavior. Any disrespectful behavior will be noted on the progress report.

-A pass/fail grade is based on student participation. All projects, activities and worksheets will earn a pass or fail designation on school tool grade book. Scores are based on a 1 – 4 scale.

- 1- Student refuses to finish assignment
- 2- Student gives minimal effort
- 3 – Student completes most of assignment
- 4 – Student completes assignment

-Students will be shown how to reserve a library book. They may reserve a book at any time. Students may use the library during study hall, flex period or if a teacher sends a student for a specific purpose. If a student is not in a class, all students are required to enter the library with a pass. At this time, the middle school has a policy that 5<sup>th</sup> graders are not allowed to check out young adult books.

-If a student has an overdue book, he/she may not check out another book until that book is returned. A student is responsible for all lost library books. He/she can either pay for or replace the lost library book.

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
