Welcome to Mrs. Hasbrouck's 8^{th} Grade Math class! I'm excited to begin a new school year and work with you this year. I'm excited to work with you and get to know you during the time we are together.

- 1. <u>Schedule</u>: Everyday you are expected to be in person. You will come into class, find your seat and take out all materials needed for the day.
- 2. <u>Supplies</u>: Students **MUST** come to class prepared for each lesson with a marble notebook, pencil, binder or folder, colored pencils, glue sticks, scissors, calculator, and highlighter.
- 3. <u>Homework</u>: Homework is assigned and is expected to be completed by the assigned Due Date. Homework may be collected and graded on occasion without warning. Oftentimes homework will be to complete remaining classwork or watch a supplemental video. When students are absent, they are responsible to make up all missed assignments.
- 4. <u>Grades</u>: Students will be given grades based on homework, classwork and assessments. Grades will be given based on accuracy and effort. The final grade for the year is the average of all four quarter grades with the final exam.

Assessments - 40% Classwork - 30% Homework - 20% Do Now - 10%

5. Extra Help: Students are encouraged to see me for extra help whenever they are having difficulty. I will have my available periods listed in Google Classroom. After School hours will vary. They will be posted in Google Classroom.

- 6. <u>Behavior</u>: We expect ALL students to follow the classroom rules as outlined in the school handbook. We cannot tolerate disruptions that prevent us from teaching or hinder other students from learning. Students are expected to participate appropriately in the classroom both virtually and in person.
- 7. Attendance: Attendance will be taken daily via Google Classroom and SchoolTool.
