## Mrs. Wright and Mrs. Hasbrouck

Supplies: A ruler, 3-ring binder (2 inch), a folder and a stylus are recommended. A scientific calculator will be used during most lessons. I strongly recommend purchasing one of these models: Texas Instruments TI-30IIS or TI-34 II, Sharp EL 531. If you would like, you may leave the calculator in its original packaging until I approve it.

Homework: There will be homework assigned practically every day and will be due and checked at the beginning of class. The assignment should be kept in the math notebook. To receive credit for your homework assignment, at least half of it must be completed. Occasionally, an assignment might be difficult to complete or hard to understand. In this case, the assigned problems must be copied onto your homework paper along with any work you were able to do in order for you to receive credit. #### Abstract
