

## Mrs. Wright's Class Expectations 2023-24

## Algebra 1 Next Generation

**Supplies:** A ruler, 3-ring binder (2 inch), a folder and a stylus are recommended. The purchase of a graphing calculator (TI-83 plus or TI 84-Plus) is highly recommended.

**Homework:** There will be homework assigned practically every day and will be due and checked at the beginning of class. The assignment should be kept in the math notebook. To receive credit for your homework assignment, at least half of it must be completed. Occasionally, an assignment might be difficult to complete or hard to understand. In this case, the assigned problems must be copied onto your homework paper along with any work you were able to do in order for you to receive credit. If homework is consistently incomplete or not finished at all, you will be asked to stay after school to complete the assignment(s).

**Grades:** Quarterly grades are based on tests (55%), quizzes (35%) and homework (10%).

Tests and quizzes cannot be retaken for a higher grade, and no extra credit will be given.

Students will be required to take the Algebra 1 Common Core Regents exam in June. The Regents Exam will contribute to 10% of your final average. To help students be successful in Algebra, a math lab has been provided every fourth day for skills review. In this lab, 8<sup>th</sup> grade skills and Algebra skills will be reviewed until the end of the year. Topics from this class will be reviewed in our class and will be on some tests and quizzes.

**Absences:** You are responsible for ALL missed work, including homework and class notes. If you are absent for a test or quiz, you will be required to take it the day you return. If you are absent the day *before* a test, you can take the test the second day after you return.

### **Class Procedures:**

1. Be on time and in your seat when the bell rings.
2. Cell phones and smart watches should be stored in your backpacks during math class.
3. When homework is assigned at the end of the period, you are expected to begin the assignment in class and work on it until the bell rings if time permits.
4. Remain seated until the bell rings.
5. If **Mrs. Wright** is absent from school and you have a substitute, you are responsible to complete all of the work assigned in class. If the work is **not** completed in class, you will have detention after school with Mrs. Wright the next day she returns.
