Course Description

Math 10 is the second course of a two-year sequence of the Algebra I Curriculum. In June of this school year, students will take the Algebra I Regents Exam, a requirement for graduation. In this course, we will cover:

- Unit 6: Systems of Equations
- Unit 7: Polynomials
- Unit 8: Quadratic Equations
- Unit 9: Quadratic Functions
- Unit 10: Statistics

A total points system will be used to calculate your grade. Each assignment/assessment will be assigned a point value that is part of the total point value in a marking period. The weight of the assignment on the final grade is based on the number of points available for a given assignment/assessment. Each assignment/assessment is your opportunity to earn points toward a better grade!
