This may include food preparation, school nutrition, institutional food service or dietetics, etc.

Applications should demonstrate an independent spirit, care and concern for others, some combination of noteworthy work experience, community service or extracurricular involvement and academic merit. In addition, the application must include two (2) non-family recommendations.

Although high academic achievement shall not be primary criteria, a reasonable expectation of success of the student at the college level shall be part of the consideration.

Attach two (2) non-family references.

This application will be considered VOID if not completed in its entirety.

Selection: Three individuals will be chosen to receive one of each of these scholarships. The scholarships will be awarded during the month of May.

These scholarships were created in memory of three former School Food Service Directors from the Hudson Valley Region.

<u>The Elvalee Woodside</u> scholarship is to honor the first Food Service Director of the Arlington Central School District. She had a positive influence on children and adults her entire life.
