Creative Crafts is a year-long course (1.0) that focuses on the Creative Arts. The Elements and Principles of Art and Design will guide students as they create a variety of functional and decorative projects. Basic concepts in drawing, painting, sculpture and collage will begin the school year. Students will build upon their knowledge and apply skills to a variety of crafts, including paper arts, fiber arts, a variety of sculpture and ceramic clay. Throughout the course, students will work through color theory, perspective and learn about a variety of artists and cultural influences.

Class Expectations:

- Students are expected to be on time, in regular attendance and prepared for class.
- Students are to complete each art project on time and in accordance with the project guidelines and rubrics. (see Google Classroom).
- No Food or Drink is allowed in the art studio without permission.

- All students are required to be part of the Google Classroom and to know how to upload images and information to assignments posted.
- All students are expected to follow the Rules of the Studio..
